2004 OFFICIALS INSURANCE PROGRAM

USSSA officials registration automatically includes general liability and accident medical insurance for officials during USSSA sanctioned activities. The policy term is January 1, 2004 through December 31, 2004.

The USSSA currently sanctions events in the following sports:

- Slow-Pitch Softball
- Fast-Pitch Softball
- Baseball
- Basketball
- Soccer
- Volleyball
- Flag/Touch Football

Requirements for automatic officials coverage include:

1. The official must be registered with USSSA.
2. Teams participating must be registered with USSSA.
3. Tournaments must be USSSA sanctioned.

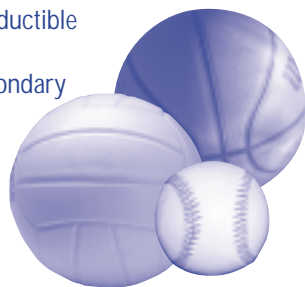
COVERAGE LIMITS General Liability

\$2,000,000 per Occurrence, \$3,000,000 Aggregate **per event**
- No Deductible

Accident Medical

\$100,000 per Occurrence - No deductible

Accident Medical Coverage is secondary to any other collectible insurance, primary if no other insurance is in force. Deductibles and co-insurance payments from primary insurance are covered.



YOU CAN BE SUED!

Every year, sports officials are sued due to alleged negligence. Some are paid officials, but many are volunteers. The USSSA officials general liability policy provides the coverage necessary for your sports officiating exposure.

Coverage is provided for:

1. Legal defense with no deductible
2. Defense of lawsuits - even if groundless
3. Payment of judgments - Up to \$2,000,000

MEDICAL EXPENSES COVERED

Accidental injuries are all too common for today's officials. The USSSA officials accident medical policy will pay your covered medical bills up to the \$100,000 policy limit, with **no deductible**.

Coverage is provided for:

1. Accidental injury while officiating.
2. Dental damage to sound and natural teeth.
3. Medical services for 52 weeks from date of injury.
4. Deductibles or co-payments unpaid by primary insurance.

This policy does not provide benefits for:

- (a) suicide or attempted suicide, sane or insane;
- (b) Injuries caused by an act of declared or undeclared war;
- (c) Injuries resulting from air travel, except while as a passenger for transportation only;
- (d) Injuries received while under the influence of any controlled substance, unless administered on the advice of a Physician;
- (e) Injuries received as a result of being intoxicated (as determined and defined by the laws in the jurisdiction in which the loss or cause of loss was incurred; for the purposes of this exception, the laws governing the operation of motor vehicles while intoxicated will apply to any activity occurring at the time of the accident;
- (f) Injuries sustained while traveling other than as specially stated in the policy;
- (g) the cost of eyeglasses, contact lenses or examinations for either;
- (h) the cost of dental treatment, except as specifically provided for injuries to sound, natural teeth;
- (i) Expenses for which benefits were paid by workers' compensation or employer's liability laws;
- (j) Treatment of hernia.

USSSA Officials Insurance is administered by Chappell Insurance Agency, Inc. and American Specialty Insurance Services, Inc. Have peace of mind knowing that you are covered by one of the best multi-sport officials programs available anywhere.

This is a brief outline of policy coverages and exclusions. This is not a policy interpretation and only the contract can speak for itself.



NON-USSSA OFFICIATING COVERAGE NOW AVAILABLE!

Once you have become a registered USSSA official, you may purchase insurance to cover organized/scheduled officiating for non-USSSA activities. Coverage is available for:

- Slow-Pitch Softball
- Fast-Pitch Softball
- Baseball
- Basketball
- Soccer
- Volleyball
- Flag/Touch Football

The coverage limits are the same as those provided for USSSA events:
